

A Message from the PTA

Happy Spring ISI Families! The PTA is currently planning several Spring activities again this year. However, it is a very unusual time with the potential of any Coronavirus impacts on many minds in this fluid situation. We will of course keep informed and make adjustments as necessary to support safety in the community.

The PTA representatives for ISI on **Grunnstoo** (Gardabaer Parent Association for primary schools), Baldur Ólafsson and Kriselle Suson Jonsðóttir have provided an update on the work being done with the Mayor of Gardabaer tied to issues identified by local primary schools; this can be found on page 2 of this newsletter.

The PTA is currently planning to sponsor it's annual **EASTER Egg Hunt** on Thursday April 2nd at 13:00 unless a change becomes necessary. This is an event the children look forward to. This is sponsored by the ISI PTA. Younger students will have the opportunity to hunt for surprise filled Easter eggs which will be hidden with the help of the older students. Then, all the students will gather in the classroom above the library in the big school building, to open eggs and turn in plastic eggs for a small snack (we recycle these each year to ensure an eco friendly event). We look forward to the annual visit from the Easter Bunny. Siblings again will be welcomed this year to participate if they are signed up in advance. Older students will help hide eggs for the event as part of school community service, and will have some deviled egg snacks. The PTA will be donating 30,000 ISK to support the older class trip currently planned to Edinburgh. In case you were wondering: The PTA membership fee of 3,000 ISK which was agreed to in the fall has not yet been processed yet we will let you know when it goes out given the delay.

They have been working with other parent representative to address local concerns. We are pleased to advise they have jointly presented issues related to safety and other concerns, in collaboration with the PTA Board and the ISI Headmistress to the Mayor of Garðabæjar. These concerns include safety issues tied to signage, crosswalk markings, lighting and traffic for consideration and action by the local authorities in order to improve the ISI school environment and safety for our school children. In addition, the Sjálandskóli parents have asked for ISI parents cooperation in signing a petition to ensure safety tied to the opening of the new restaurant nearby. An e-mail message with more details has been sent to allow parents to participate and better understand the concerns. Our thanks to Baldur and Kriselle for their active and important ISI representation on Grunnstoð.
